## Journal Article

### **In-text:**

Hospitalized patients reported improvements to mood following pet therapy visits (Coakley & Mahoney, 2009, p. 144).

### **Reference List:**

## Book

### **In-text:**

With one author: Quote (Author's Last Name, Year, p. Page Number)

Example: (Marotz, 2020, p. 284)

With one author: Paraphrase (Author's Last Name, Year)

Example: (Marotz, 2020)

With two authors: Quote: (First Author's Last Name & Second Author's Last Name, Year, p. Page Number)

Example: (Vincent & Amalberti, 2016, p. 13)

With two authors: Paraphrase: (First Author's Last Name & Second Author's Last Name, Year)

Example: (Vincent & Amalberti, 2016)

### **Reference List:**

General format for books

Author(s)' or Editor(s) Last Name, First Initial. Second Initial, if given. (Year of publication). *Title of book* (additional information if applicable, e.g. edition, volume, etc.). Publisher Name. DOI or URL

Example:

Marotz, L. R. (2020). *Health, safety, and nutrition for the young child* (10th ed.). Cengage Learning.

## Book Chapter

**In-Text Citation:** Quote (Author's Last Name, Year, p. Page Number)

Example: (Stockert & Taylor, 2014, p. 998)

**In-Text Citation:** Paraphrase (Author's Last Name, Year)

Example: (Stockert & Taylor, 2014)

### **Reference List:**

Author(s) of chapter or entry. (Year of publication). Title of chapter or entry. Editor(s), *Title of book*

(additional information if applicable, e.g. edition, volume, page numbers). Publisher Name. DOI or URL

Example:

Jordon, J. V. (2013). Relational resilience in girls. In S. Goldstein & R. B. Brooks (Eds.), *Handbook of resilience in children* (2nd ed., pp. 73–86). Springer. [https://doi.org/10.1007/978-1-4614-3661-4\\_5](https://doi.org/10.1007/978-1-4614-3661-4_5)

## Website/blog

**In-text:** Quote (Author's Last Name, Year, Location of quote)

Example: (Button, 2019, para. 3)

**In-text:** paraphrase (Author's Last Name, Year)

Example: (Button, 2019)

### **Reference List:**

Webpage on a news website:

### **YouTube video**

**In-text:** Quote (Last Name or User Name of person or group who uploaded the video, Year, Timestamp for beginning of quote)

Examples:

(BearPaw, 2016, 1:15)

(Kinchlow, 2011, 1:07)

**In-text:** Paraphrase (Creator's Last Name, Year)

Examples

(BearPaw, 2016)

(Kinchlow, 2011)

### **Personal communication/conversation/interview**

(e-mail messages, private letters, telephone conversations, and notes taken during a class lecture)

**In-text:** Include the initials and surname of the communicator and the exact date

Example: During a lecture, Professor D. Forrest discussed ... (personal communication, May, 31, 2020).

In a telephone interview with the association's vice president ... (H. Klein, personal communication, November 15, 2019).

**Reference List:** These types of sources are not included in the reference list, only in-text.

### **Industry report**

**In-text:** Quote (Author's Last Name, Year, p. Page Number)

Example: (Gonzales, 2019, p. 3)

**In-text:** Paraphrase (Author's Last Name, Year)

Example: (Gonzales, 2019)

**Reference List:** Author. (date). *Title*. Database. URL.

Example:

Gonzales, E. (2019, September). *Paint manufacturing in Canada: Industry report 32551CA*. IBISWorld. <https://www.ibisworld.com>
